# CITY PARK Master Plan: Second Public Meeting - KEY FINDINGS

- Improve park entrances by making them safer for pedestrians through traffic control strategies, and implementing signage and wayfinding to guide users to the park.
- Improve ADA accessibility and safety for pedestrians and bikers throughout the park with protected bike lanes and bike racks, safe crossings, shade trees, and lighting.
- Make the north part of the park more accessible through various modes of transportation, including a shuttle, trolleys, or a train for internal circulation, and paddling for water access.
- Desire for bike/greenway connections to extend beyond the park and connect with existing bike networks.




